- ※ Total distance exceeding 10 km and not exceeding 50 km: 100 won for every 5km

- ※ When the subway lines of both the Seoul metro area and other localities outside Seoul are used together, the subway fare system of the Seoul metro area is applied first, and 100 won is added for every 4 km traveled on lines outside the Seoul metro area (Yeongtaek-Sinchang, Gyeonggi-Chuncheon).
- ※ Free for senior citizens aged 65 or older, the disabled, and national meritorious persons
- ※ Complimentary from subway to bus is allowed up to 4 times a day

What to do when you left your belongings in the subway
 If you have lost or misplaced any of your belongings using the train, please report to the subway station office and inform the staff immediately. The station staff members can better assist you if you provide details, such as the train number, the points of entry and exit, seat number, and the time you exited the train. If you discover at a later time that you have lost or misplaced any of your belongings, you may call the subway stations operating the Lost and Found Center of the subway line you took you. You may also visit the website of the subway stations operating the Lost and Found Center to check the respective information page.

May
 • Yeoncheon Paleolithic Festival
 The Yeoncheon Jeongok-ri Paleolithic Festivals held in the historic site of Jeongok-ri and Jeongok-eup in Yeoncheon. The event is an edu-entertainment festival in which the Paleolithic and prehistoric cultures can be learned and enjoyed by participating in education and play activities.

June
 • Ansan Street Arts Festival
 Ansan Street Arts Festival is known as the representative culture and arts festival of Ansan-si. The festival features diverse street performances by various domestic and overseas street performance teams at Ansan Culture Square.

July
 • Buecheon International Comics Festival
 Asia's best comics festival, Buecheon International Comics Festival, is intended to celebrate the dreams, challenges, passions, and infinite possibilities of youths by featuring the theme, "Youth".

August
 • Jarasum International Jazz Festival in Gapyeong
 The Jarasum International Jazz Festival is held annually in October. Since its inception in 2004, the festival was participated by about 30 teams from 12 countries including the U.S., Japan, Sweden, and Norway. The yearly festival, nicknamed "JJ Festival," is a rich music festival that annually attracts over 100 thousand visitors from home and abroad.

September
 • Suwon Hwaseong Cultural Festival
 Suwon Hwaseong Cultural Festival is a representative traditional culture and tour festival of Suwon. The festivals held at Suwon Hwaseong Fortress, a UNESCO World Cultural Heritage site. Visitors can enjoy diverse performances and experiential events such as the beautiful Suwon Lantern Festival on Suwon Stream.

October
 • Icheon Rice Cultural Festival
 Icheon Rice Cultural Festival aims to be a tourist attraction recognized across the country by featuring rice, both the symbol of Icheon-si and autumn harvest, as well as the highlight of farming culture. The festival offers opportunities to experience traditional agricultural culture for children and adolescents.

November
 • Paju Jangdan Soybean Festival
 This festival is both fun and delicious! In the Imjingak area and Imjingak Pyeonghwa-Nuri Park, visitors will be fascinated by the sight of enormous colorful spheres of five colors, which portray an image of the Jangdan soybean. In the Bean Experience Village, visitors can enjoy various hands-on programs. There are also delicious dishes on display such as tofu, bean bread, and bean porridge.

Gorjam Station Gyeonggi Ceramic Museum
 Gyeonggi Ceramic Museum is located in Gwangju, Gyeonggi-do, and specializes in the study of traditional Korean ceramics. The museum was established in 2001 to collect, preserve, study, and exhibit materials pertaining to Bunwon Gwanryo (government kiln) of Saongwon and its ceramics. The museum has worked to collect and preserve traditional Korean ceramics heritages, and has held exhibitions for the public to easily appreciate the ceramics culture.

Icheon Station Icheon World Ceramic Center
 Icheon World Ceramic Center, located within Seolbong Park, Icheon-si, was established for the exhibition and research of ceramics. The space is created as a cultural complex that includes a ceramic gallery, which shows trends in the world of ceramic art, and the creation residency and craft workshops, which promote artists to focus on creative activities, and experiential facilities.

Icheon Station Yeongyeongneung Royal Tomb
 The name "Yeongyeongneung" was coined from the names of two tombs: Yeongneung(영릉) and Yeongneung(영릉). Yeongneung was the joint tomb of the 4th ruler of the Joseon Dynasty, King Sejong and his wife Queen Soheon. Yeongneung was the royal tomb of the 17th ruler of the Joseon Dynasty, King Hyojong, and of his wife Queen Inseon. King Sejong's great accomplishment was the creation of Hangeul, the Korean alphabet. King Hyojong's contribution to the national economy was the application of the Daedong-beop (Uniform Land Tax Law), which unified the tax system.  The one-thousand-year-old Silleuksa Temple is said to have been built by Monk Wonhyo during the Silla period. The temple attracts many tourists throughout the year, thanks to its unique location along a riverside and the beautiful landscape of Namhangang River (Yeogang River). The temple offers temple stay programs for visitors to experience Buddhist culture.

Cheongyeongsong Station Petite France
 Petite France is a theme park based on Le Petit Prince, a novel by Saint-Exupéry. France Traditional House Exhibition Hall displays a 150-year-old French house. The characters from the novel are made into statues and placed throughout the exotic buildings. Visitors will find much to do and see in Petite France. A marionette puppet show is staged every day. Petite France was also the filming location featured in the drama series, "My Love from the Star," for its romantic scene.

 The arboretum has beautiful flowers and trees covering the 33,000 m² land. The arboretum consists of 20 gardens of different themes, including a Korean-style garden. In the winter, from December to March, the "Lighting Festival" is held annually and the gardens are adorned with fantastic lighting.

 The recreation area is located across a wide field along the riverside of Bukhangang River. Camping sites and condos around Daeseong-ri Station are a popular group outing destinations among college students. Strolling trails and bike paths along the riverside are particularly good places for dating. There are also places for water leisure sports such as waterskiing, wakeboarding, and banana boat rides.

Uijeongbu Light Rail Transit Uijeongbu City Hall Station Uijeongbu Sopong-gil
 Consisting of a total of nine courses, the sopong-gil is the tourist intersection of nature, history, and culture of Uijeongbu. The name "sopong" originated from the poem "Gwecheon" (meaning "Back to Heaven") by Cheon Sang-byong, a native of Uijeongbu. As you take Course 1 (Trail of Meditation) which includes Jikdong Theme Park and Wonsimsa Temple, you can enjoy walking along the well-shaded road with trees, while treading on the dirt path.

Uijeongbu Jungang Station Uijeongbu Budae Jigae Street
 If you want to taste the original budae jigae, Uijeongbu is the place to visit. Today's tasty budae jigae was born around 50 years ago when ham, sausages, and bacon from the U.S. military were mixed with red pepper paste and kimchi. On Budae Jigae Street, there are different kinds of restaurants including "Odong Sikdang," which was featured in the hit Korean comic strip Sikgaek (meaning "Chef") by Huh Young-man.

Gyeongui-Jungang Line

Munsan Station Imjingak Pyeonghwa-Nuri Park
 The park is located across from Imjingak Pavilion, a symbol of the national division. Inspired artworks created in the hope of achieving peaceful reunification are installed in the outdoor space. In particular, "Windy Hill" presents an extraordinary view of around 3,000 pinwheels spinning in the wind. There is an observatory to view the land of North Korea across the Imjingak River. On display is a rusty steam engine train that is "still wanting to run." Here, visitors may feel the longing and pain of the national division.

Deskop Station Myojeoks Temple
 Sitting at the foot of Myojeoksan Mountain, Myojeoks Temple was established during King Mumu's reign of Silla. The small and peaceful temple is a good place to quiet your mind, and it offers a temple stay experience program. Visitors can observe various relics, such as an octagonal seven-story stone pagoda. They can also visit Nahajong Hall which was created inside a natural cave and view a Stone Seated Sakyamuni Buddha modeled after the saedeva statue in Seokgung Grotto.

Paldang Station Namhangang River Bike Path
 This 148.5km-long bike path stretches from Paldangdaegu Bridge in Gyeonggi-do to Tangeumdaegu Bridge in Chungju. Bikers can enjoy an engaging ride along the river as they view beautiful sceneries along a path that is lined with famous restaurants and historical sites. The now-defunct railroad of Jungang Line is a particularly unique attraction. The 27 km-long railroad stretches from Paldang Bridge to Yangpyeong.

Yangsu Station Dumulmeori
 Dumulmeori is located where Bukhangang River and Namhangang River meet. There was a ferry in this area before Paldang Dam was built, and the ferry was the last resting place for those sailing for Tulseong Island and Mapo Ferry.
