The Eight Sights of Gapyeong


Sight 1 Cheongpyeong Lake (5B)



Homyeongsan Mountain stands tall in both sides of the lake and forms a great harmony with the clear lake, attracting visitors throughout the year especially for water sports such as water skiing.

Sight 2 Homyeong Lake (4C)



It is the upper reservoir of the nation's first-ever pumped-storage power plant. This vast reservoir, coupled with the beautiful terrain of Homyeongsan Mountain reminds of the gorgeous Cheonji Lake of Baekdusan Mountain.

Sight 3 Yongchu valley (3C)



The name of Yongchu Valley, which originates from the 1068-meter-tall Yeonnsan Mountain, came from the picturesque sight of nine bends that were known to be carved out by a dragon while it ascended into the sky. It is also the only valley in the metropolitan area with intact ecosystem, exuding a sense of mystique as if the rocks flow like water.

Sight 4 Fall Foliage of Myeongisan Mountain (2B)



Myeongisan is the second tallest mountain in Gyeonggi-do with an altitude of 1,267m. Over 100,000 people visit every year, and the waterfall and the forest of the n valley form a magnificent spectacle. Especially in the fall season, you can enjoy hiking in the midst of harmony between old trees and unique-shaped rocks as well as the wonderful sight of the autumn maple leaves.

Sight 5 Jeongmok Pool (1B)



Sharp-nosed lenoks, a natural monument, inhabit the area. There is a clear, deep pond named Yongso at about 3 km in the upstream from 3-8 Bridge, and the legend has it that a pregnant woman found a dragon ascending to heaven, which then fell to the ground to form a pond.

Sight 6 Manggyeongdae Peak of Unaksan Mountain (2B)



935-meter-tall Unaksan Mountain presents a magnificent view of unique-shaped rocks and peaks that pierce through the clouds, just as the name suggests. The scenic views include Hyeondeungsas, a temple located on the midslope of the mountain, and Baengnyeong Falls and Nurkseop Rock. During your hike, you can enjoy the mountains, valleys and forests and also immerse yourself in the stillness of Hyeondeungsas, a thousand-year-old temple.

Sight 7 Chungnyeong Pine Forest (4B)



Located at a 4 km point of National Road No. 37 (Imcho-ri), Chungnyeong Pine Forest is a recreation area with a total area of 4,358㎡. Made of 30- to 50-year-old nut pine trees, it was established as a seed production forest by Gyeonggi-do seated at the foot of the 886-meter-tall Chungnyeongsan Mountain.

Sight 8 Yumyeong Valley (6C)



A cultural village is located nearby.





ZipWire 3C
It is the largest zip line facility in Asia. Gapyeong Pine Nut Rice Wine
It is the highest-level makgeolli — unrefined rice wine — brewed by the traditional manufacturing method with natural bedrock water from 250 m underground in Hyeon-ri of the pure Gapyeong, high-quality rice and carefully selected nut pines. It is produced in a thorough hygiene control system for reliable quality.

Jazz Island Wine
They are premium red wine, rose wine and brandy brewed in the traditional French way with grapes raised with rain-shelter cultivation, which are produced in Unaksan Mountain of the pure Gapyeong.

Jarasmus Mulled Wine
Meaning hot wine in French, vin chaud is a luxurious European beverage. Developed by Martial Blanchon, a famous chef from Bourgogne, France, and produced in Gapyeong, it is the official beverage of the Jarasmus International Jazz Festival.

Gapyeong Grape
They are soft grapes with a high sugar content cultivated in the blessed natural conditions in the pure, cool Gapyeong's mountain areas, which show an annual average of 12°C and a night-day temperature difference in harvest times of over 10°C.

Gapyeong Apple
As they are cultivated in mountainous regions with a large daily temperature range, the grapes are juicy and have a high sugar content, known for its tasty and soft flesh.

Gapyeong Pine Nut
