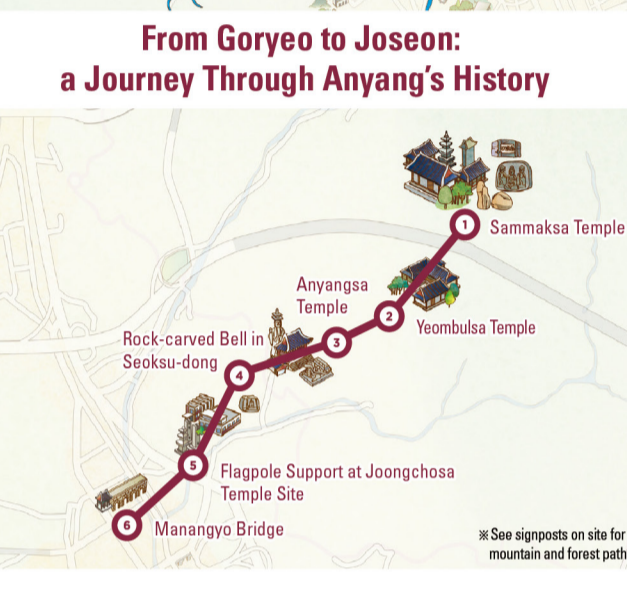
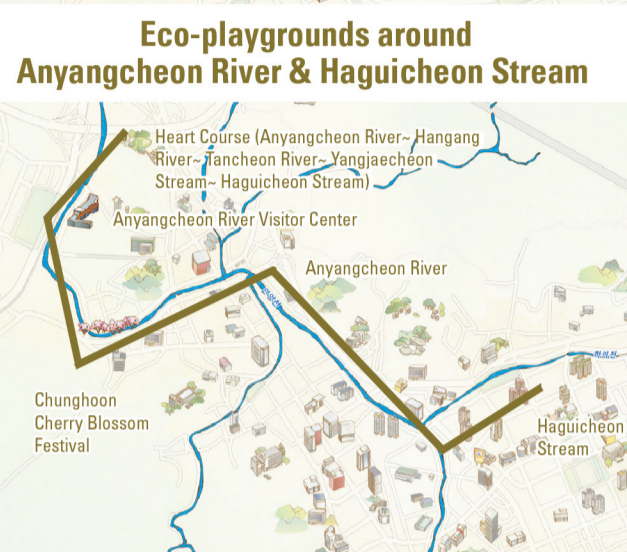
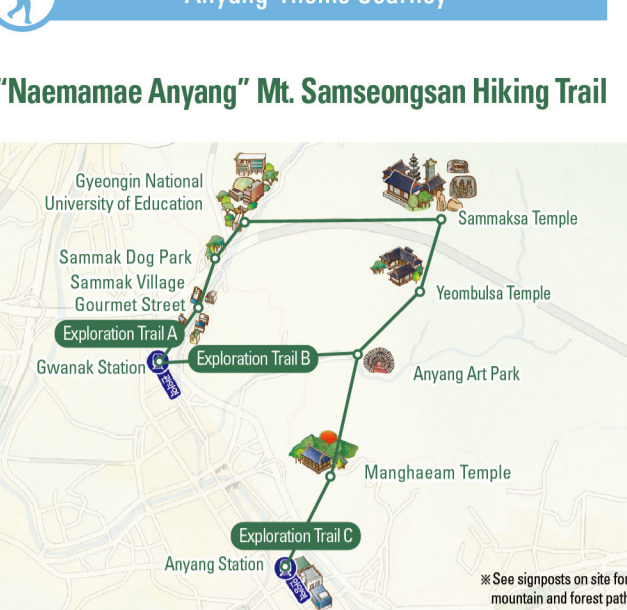
Anyang's Eight Scenic Spots

- Scenic View 1 | View of the sunset from Manghaem Temple**
 Manghaem(望海庵) is a historical temple (3rd year of Seung of Joseon), meaning a hermitage to see the sea, where you can enjoy viewing the setting sun at the Yellow Sea.

- Scenic View 2 | Female and Male Gwanaksan Rocks of Sammaksa Temple**
 It is said that Naemyonggyeok, created by rocks weathered for thousands of years, has the benefits of preservation, prosperity, disease-free and long life.

- Scenic View 3 | Pyeongchon Central Park**
 The year-round festival, ceremonies, and events are held in a comprehensive building space that combines formal gardens, sports facilities, and public works of art.

- Scenic View 4 | Catholic Holy Place of Mt. Surisan**
 A pilgrimage site that promotes the vitality of faith against the persecution of Catholics in the late Joseon and the history and culture of the tobacco culture sites.

- Scenic View 5 | Stone Pagodas in Byeongmogan Forest Park**
 A stone pagoda that relieves the natural and artistic beauty by using 55,000 stones that hold the spirit of Surisan Mountain. It is a landmark of Gyeonggi province and Surisan Mountain.

 This is an arched stone bridge built by Jeonggi of Joseon (1795) so that the people may conveniently use it for many years. This shows the stone bridge style of the Joseon Era.

 Old Seo-myeon Office (Cultural Property Material of Gyeonggi-do No. 100) was formerly an administrative office. It preserves the architecture and being style during the Japanese occupation era.

- 6 Gwangyang Bronze Age Historic Site** E2
 This is a place where the Bronze Age settlement and various artifacts were excavated in 2002. There are pit houses, ovens and primitive human models installed to help understand the prehistoric bronze age dwelling style.

- 7 Anyangsa Temple** C2
 This is the temple where the name of the location, "Anyang," was originated from. It is said that Taejo Wang Gyun established that temple. Anyangsa Temple is now re-established in honor of the old Anyang Temple after the Korean War, and there are cultural assets such as Gubeo and Budo of the Goryeo Dynasty.

 It is a temple that Taejo Gwiso founded and where he lived as a monk during the Gilla era. Located on the hillside of Samnaksan Mountain, it has beautiful scenery.
