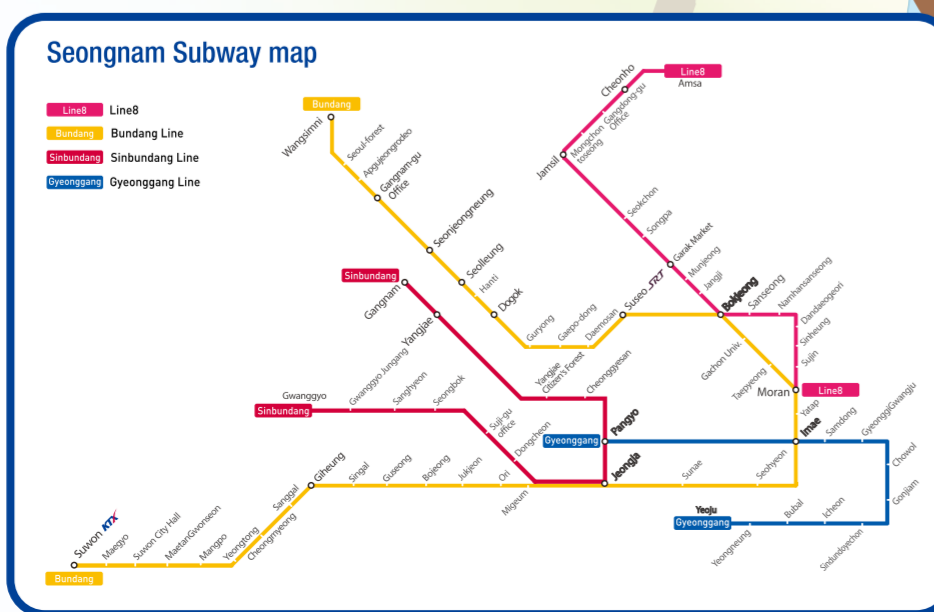

Bongguksa (temple), Daegwangmyeongjeon

A special Temple in downtown
Bongguksa (temple), Gyeonggi-do Tangible Cultural Property No. 101, was rebuilt in 1674 by King Heonjong for the repose of his early dead two princesses. This temple was originally built for Vairocana Buddha but it is currently dedicated to Amitabha Buddha. The Daegwangmyeongjeon is a temple building that has preserved the Buddhist temple style in the latter part of Joseon Dynasty.

Seongnam Art Center

The Place changing life to art
Seongnam Art Center has opera house, concert hall, and ensemble theatre and it has been positioned as the space of special culture and art, with beautiful landscape for people's recreation and self-cultivation. Gwangju Namhansanseong, the ramparts in the east of Seoul
The historical, cultural value of Namhansanseong Fortress was highly recognized, it was newly registered as world heritage by the general meeting of Unesco hosted in Doha, Qatar, June 2014. Climbing along well organized mountain road for 20 minutes, you can meet the low fortress like folding screen along the beautiful curve, and the mountain view of 490 above sea level, the view of Seoul and Seongnam will be spread in front of you.

Neoreunmot / Music Fountains Square
This space shows beautiful scenic views in harmony between outdoor music fountains and Byeokcheon Lake and plays a role in cultural space for recreation and culture by outdoor wedding ceremony, concert, and film screening.

Workout Center 4F
Opened the facility which used to be an employee welfare facility to the citizen during working hour, the basic of health and how to use fitness machine are instructed in this leisure sport space.

Jungang Park at the center of the city is the representing green space in harmony of forest and lake. Lawn Square, Evergreen Square, Yeokmal Square, and Hwangsaoul Square give you diverse experiences and comfort, and open-air theatre offers cultural events and performances. You can get a taste of rural area and traditional culture through Goindol Garden and Sunaengdang House which have been restored from local cultural properties and cannot be seen in downtown. 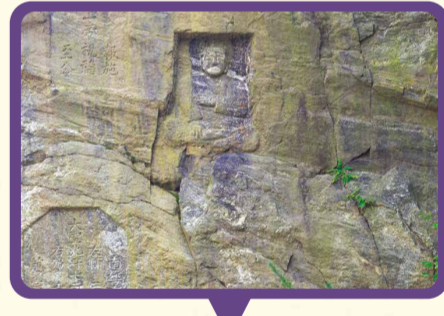
