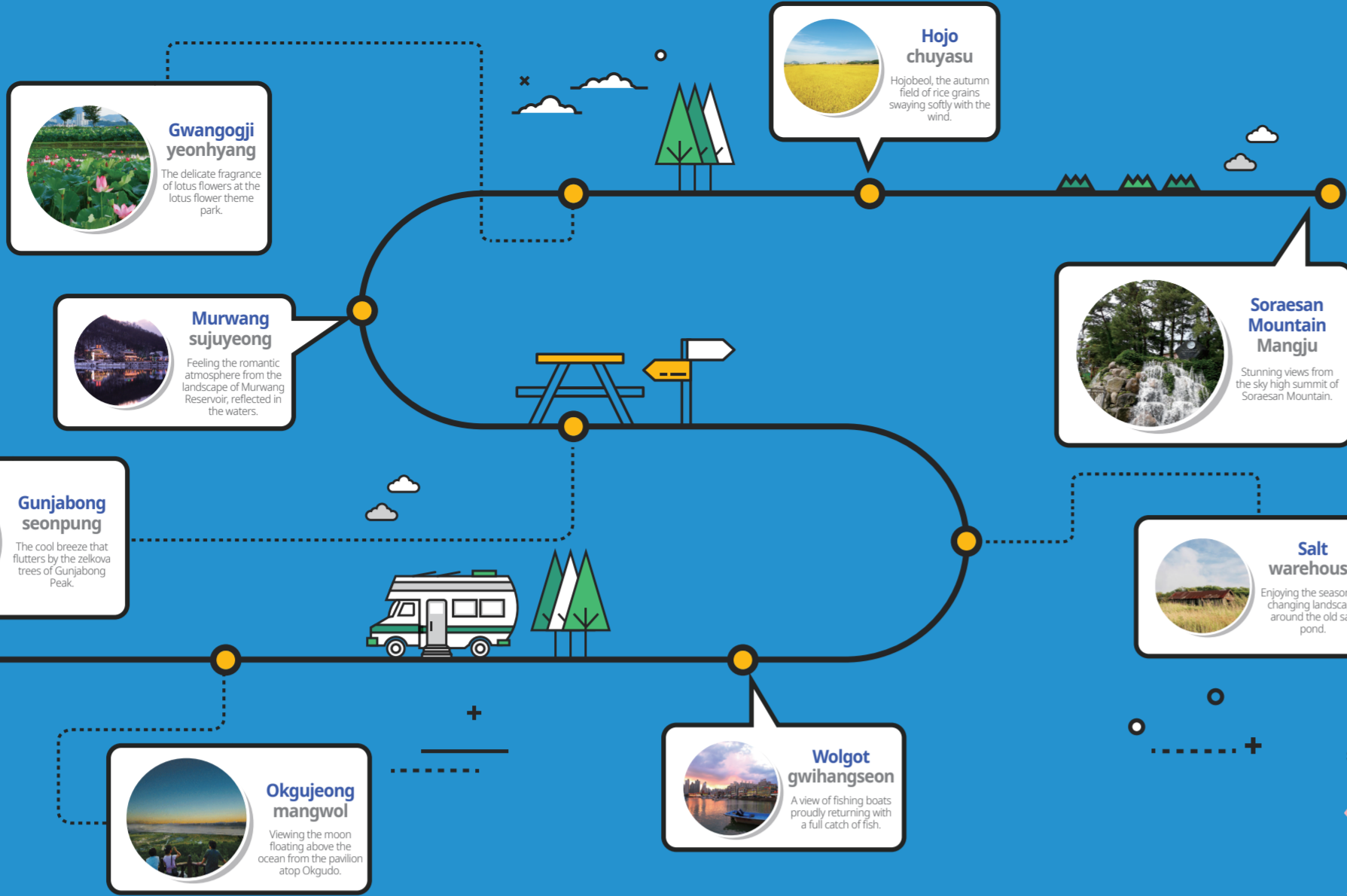


Scenic Tour of Siheung

Introducing a lively, romantic landscape: 9 ways to enjoy Siheung's grand scenery!

Siheung's 9 most famous tourist attractions have beautiful scenery and their stories are as beautiful as their names. Oido Island is an area connected to land, but was originally an island. Gwangokjijehonnyang used to be a village of white lotus flowers with red tips which were planted with seeds brought over from the Ming Dynasty. Discover these fragrant, colorful and lively stories for yourself!

"Easily Accessible Island" by Subway Oido Island

With its beautiful sunsets, Oido Island is easily accessible by taking subway line no. 4 to Oido Station and a short bus ride, making it a convenient travel destination for families or couples without a car.

Famous Oido Island Landmark Oido Red Lighthouse

Built as a marine tourism facility as part of a fishing village development project, Oido Red Lighthouse is now a symbolic landmark of Oido Island. The lighthouse is used as an observatory where the refreshing sea breeze and expansive view of the West Sea provide an uplifting experience.



Complex Cultural Space Shinsegae Premium Outlets

Boasting an exotic appearance of Spanish architecture, Shinsegae Premium Outlets is a complex cultural space that offers shopping and leisure with over 220 famous domestic and international fashion brands, as well as a Central Garden with eco-friendly landscaping, a Pet Park for walking dogs, a Futsal Court, a VR Experience Zone, etc.

Travel back in time to the Neolithic Era Oido Prehistoric Relics Park

Oido Island is covered with shell mound relics and has a prehistoric site where comb-pattern pottery representative of the Neolithic culture, stoneware, etc. have been found. Formed with the concept of Oido Island prehistoric culture, the Prehistoric Relics Park is a great experiential, educational site for children with views of dugouts, people from prehistoric times, earthenware, etc. as well as an all-encompassing view of how people adapted and settled on the coast during the Neolithic Age. (Historic Site No. 441)



Unique abundance and experiences Oido Hamsang Observatory Deck

Created by utilizing a 250-ton retired maritime police patrol ship, Oido Island Hamsang Observatory Deck offers visitors a variety of experiences and exhibitions of Oido Island's unique history, lifestyle, and ecology that combines the sea, land, people, and nature in the Exhibition Hall and Experiential Education Zone.

Perfect for enjoying Oido Island and West Sea Sunrise and Sunsets Okgu Park

An eco-friendly park comprised of Gohyang Hill, Mugunghwa Garden, Wetland Garden, Lotus Zone, etc., Okgu Park is a place of relaxation in the center of town with grand sights of the beautiful sunset over the West Sea from the top of the park (elevation 95m) at Okgujeong Nakjodae and an unobstructed view all the way to Songdo, Incheon.



Diverse History · Culture · Tourism Oido Museum

View the history of Siheung and Oido Island at the Siheung Oido Museum, set to open in the second half of 2019. Enjoy the Permanent Exhibition Hall that portrays living culture of the Neolithic Age in Siheung and Oido relics (Historic Site No. 441) and the variety of cultural assets excavated from all over Siheung, a Children's Experience Zone to experience prehistoric culture, and a prehistoric culture-coastal Ecological Education Program with experts! Travel back in time to the prehistoric ages with vivid relics, fun education, and rest areas!



Where the Moon Comes to Stay Wolgot Harbor

Encompassing leisure and relaxation unique to the West Sea, Wolgot Harbor is a trail up the west coast with beautiful sunsets, making it perfect for a romantic date. Enjoy fresh, raw fish at the numerous raw fish restaurants lining Wolgot Harbor and create memories with your significant other or family under the nightscapes of the port.



A legendary house with a 400 year history Saeng-Geumjib

A residence for 12 generations of the Geumyeong Kim family, Saeng-Geumjib was completely remodeled in 2005 based on the original form of the house reconstructed in 1913. Not only is this house a great resource that provides insight into the lifestyle of a traditional house in this region, it also holds value as the place where the legend of Saeng-Geumjib was created with the lesson of living within one's means. (Siheung-si Local Remains No. 7)



Enjoyed as a Seawater Pool Baegot Hanul Park

Built with a shoreline backdrop from Wolgot Port to Oido Island, Baegot Hanul Park was designed under the spirit of "Siheung, city of life" to meet the goal of becoming "a city of humanity" and "a city of nature" and offers six themed attractions including Helen Keller, King Sejong, the Wright Brothers, James Watt, Admiral Yi Sun-Shin, and Beethoven.



Where industry and culture come together Changgong

A specialized cultural space created with unused space an industrial complex as part of a cultural rehabilitation project. Changgong is a platform for a complex cultural space in an industrial complex and also the hub for gathering and spreading artists in the area through manufacturing industry cultural branding programs, etc.



Communal Cultural Space Doil Ajitaeu

Utilized as a community space for local residents by remodeling unused space in the area with a "Village Cafe 50" operated as a local co-op and a local business revitalization project (flea market) by utilizing spaces in cafes and alleys within the market.



Wolgot Art Market Art Dock

A space offering a living cultural arts foundation to local residents through the creation of cultural arts and operation of locally-specialized programs. Art Dock is operated as a living cultural art space with local participants and contributes to the promotion of cultural welfare in the region by developing cultural content that takes advantage of local characteristics.



Bursting with Art Art and Eco Cube

The Art and Eco Cube Project was selected as a city development project in 2013 by the Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, and Transport and completed construction of the Theme Zone in 2016. It preserves the formative value as a city landmark by recycling idle sewage industrial facilities through the development of programs and creative spaces based on culture, art, exhibition, and ecology by local participants. Additionally, it attempts to revitalize the area through urban renewal of the industrial complex by creating an eco-friendly complex cultural space that can be shared with locals.

Finding Vitality after 65 Years Siheung Doil Market

Doil Market is located near the Gunja-dong Community Center in Siheung-si. After opening in 1959, Doil Market is the only traditional market in Siheung that hosts a 5-day market. This area was formed as part of the Saemaeul Movement, a village development aid, and had a cattle market at one point before becoming the hub of the Gunja region as a Janggaegwan in 1960.



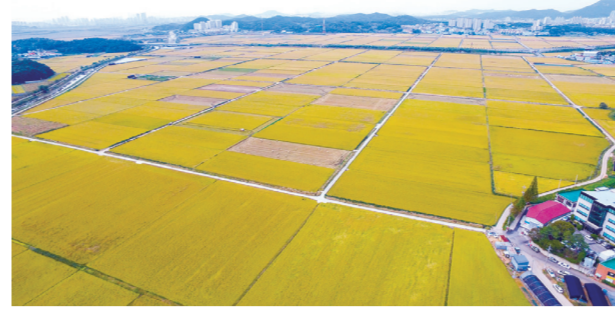
Housekeeping on a Full Stomach Siheung Jeongwang Market

15 years after development, Jeongwang Market was recognized as a traditional market in July 2016 and has 63 registered stalls across two buildings. After the Sihwa Industrial Complex and many other industrial parks were established, Jeongwang-dong naturally became an area of multi-culturalism as the small to medium-sized businesses hired many foreign laborers and is a special place where visitors can experience traditional foods from various countries.



A vast granary with a 300 year history Hojobeol

Originally created to reclaim land by stacking embankments during the Joseon Dynasty, the farmlands of Hojobeol encompasses the knowledge and experience our ancestors used to transform the land into farmland.



Purity and Beauty of Nature Yongdo Tree Garden

Located at the foot of Yangjisan Mountain and designated as the no.3 arboretum by the Gyeonggi-do provincial government, Yongdo Tree Garden is a place to experience the purity and beauty of nature. Designed with kids in mind, the arboretum is a place to experience culture, arts, and nature and features vast grass fields, over 300 species of wild flowers, and a variety of animal life, making it a natural ecological arboretum.



Historic and Natural Shelter Soraesan Mountain Forest Park

At 299.6m above sea level, Soraesan Mountain is visited by residents of nearby Incheon and Bucheon for its remarkable natural landscape. The forest park is loved as a place to relax and relieve stress with its various sports facilities, the "Forest of Reading," and the wooden rope at the "Forest of Strength."



Statue of Buddha in Soraesan Mountain Standing Rock-carved Bodhisattva

Carved into a rock wall half way up Soraesan Mountain, the Standing Rock-carved Bodhisattva is thought to have been made during the early Goryeo Dynasty. The Bodhisattva is wearing a gorgeous, cylindrical, jeweled crown decorated with vines on his head. The round face, large eyes, nose and lips, and the elongated ears and three paths around the neck evokes a serious atmosphere.



The Ceramic History of Siheung Bangsan-dong Celadon and White Porcelain Kiln Site

The "Bangsan-dong Celadon and White Porcelain Kiln Site" is an important historic site that provides evidence of the manufacturing of bricks towards the end of the Unified Silla Period and celadon and white porcelain during the early Goryeo Dynasty. Enjoy the beautiful village scenery and ceramic sculptures along the 1km trail starting from the rear entrance of Pori Elementary School to the kiln site.



A Science Experience Playground Siheung-si Agricultural Technology Center Planetarium

In efforts to improve the knowledge of astronomy science and make it more mainstream, Siheung-si spent 500 million won to create the Agricultural Technology Center Planetarium so that citizens can experience the majestic and marvels of space. The planetarium features a 500mm wide telescope that can be used to gaze upon the stars at the main observatory, a 5m wide dome screen digital observatory, and an agricultural science education center.



Ruins revealing a glimpse of prehistoric culture Neung-gok-dong Prehistoric Remains

While developing Neung-gok-dong into a new city, numerous artifacts and remains from earthenware and huts from the prehistoric times to graves from the Joseon Dynasty were uncovered. The 24 prehistoric huts have been determined to be built 6,000 years ago as a small village. Preserved within the park, which is always open, the remains are considered to be a very important discovery for the study of prehistoric culture particularly in the western coast of Korea.



The Beautiful Sea of Lotus Flowers Lotus Flower Theme Park

Lotus Flower Theme Park features a variety of lotus flowers and aquatic plants to honor the symbolic and historic meaning of Gwangogji. The walking trails and bike paths surrounding the theme park is great for family outings, and the lotus flowers that bloom during the end of July and early September are a spectacular sight. In addition, various programs involving the sun and stars are offered at the planetarium located on the 3rd floor of the Agricultural Life Technology Center.



A Place with Beautiful Scenery and Restaurants Murwang Reservoir

Initially popularized by fishing enthusiasts during the 1950s, the Murwang Reservoir now boasts beautiful cafes and restaurants, making it a great place for families and couples of the metropolitan area to visit.

A friendly traditional market Sammi market

A vast array of foods and goods are sold at Sammi Market, the largest traditional market in Siheung. The street of food stalls offers visitors an inexpensive way to try loved foods while enjoying heart-filled conversations. An exciting market atmosphere is created through regular cultural performances and events hosted at the market.

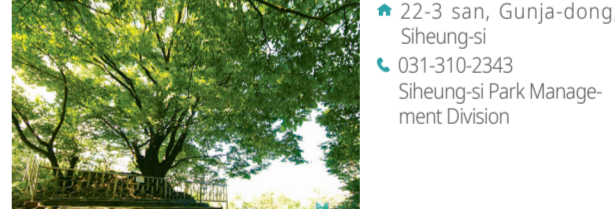
A New Photographers' Hotspot Bicycle Bridge

The beautiful backdrop of the sunrise and sunset along the bicycle shaped bridge in Siheung Gaetgol Ecological Park is becoming popular as a new hotspot among photographers.



Resembling a Lotus Flower Gunjabong Peak

With an elevation of just 198m, Gunjabong Peak is said to have been named for its resemblance to the lotus flower, one of the most noble flowers. The hiking trail to Gunjabong Peak, Neumnaegil (forest path) section, is a popular trekking course among residents of the metropolitan area. Hundreds-of-year-old zelkova trees and gunjeseonghwangjalsi sit atop the mountain, and the 500-year-old traditional ceramic Gunjabong Seonghwangje (Gyeonggi-do, Intangible Cultural Asset no. 59) is held every October 3 of the lunar calendar at Gunjabong Peak to pray for the well-being of the village and its residents.



Situated on the Sea Route within the Gaetgol Camping Grounds

The Gaetgol Camping Ground is a nature-friendly place to enjoy the atmosphere of Gaetgol and experience the low and high tides of the sea with family in the city. See the salt pond culture of the past at the salt pond experience zone, the 80-year-old salt warehouse, the tidal mud flat and coastal wetland, and the diverse animal life inhabiting Gaetgol Ecological Park.



The leader of the camping culture Murwang Forest Camping Park

Located nearby Siheung Murwang Reservoir, the Murwang Forest Camping Park is not as well-known as it just opened in May of this year, but the beautiful fairy-tale-like scenery makes it a great place to create unforgettable camping memories. The caravan, which can sleep up to four people, and the public showers and sink allow for a pleasant camping experience.



Culture and Tourism Festival in Siheung

Siheung Gaetgol Festival

Selected as the 2018 "Promising Festival" by the Ministry of Culture, Sports and Tourism, the Siheung Gaetgol Festival is an ecological cultural wine festival held held at Siheung Gaetgol Ecological Park, located in the only mudflat in Gyeonggi Province. Through the natural environment of the Gaetgol Ecology Park that provides a space where humanity and nature come together, you can enjoy a variety of programs based on two themes of art and performance in nature.

Walgot Harbor Festival

Residents of Walgot created this festival to advance the development and revitalization of the region. The festival presents seasonal treats such as shrimp and roasted whole fish, and a variety of experience events are held at the festival venue. In addition to the plaza of Miraeart Tower, which is the main attraction of the festival, there is a variety of attractions that can also be enjoyed during this abundant festival setting such as the Art Market at Art Dock.

Murwang Arts Festival

The Murwang Art Festival is a local art festival that brings together men, women, children, and community groups to participate directly in artistic activities and also enjoy high-quality art and performances by professional artists.
