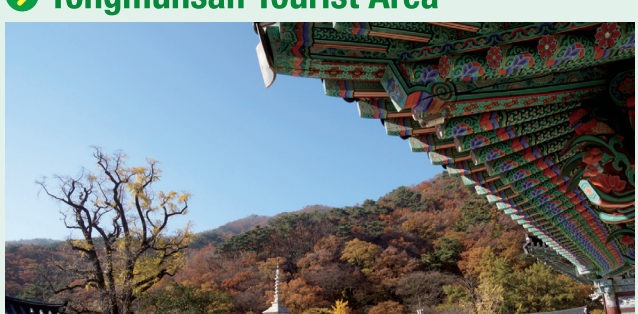
Swija Park

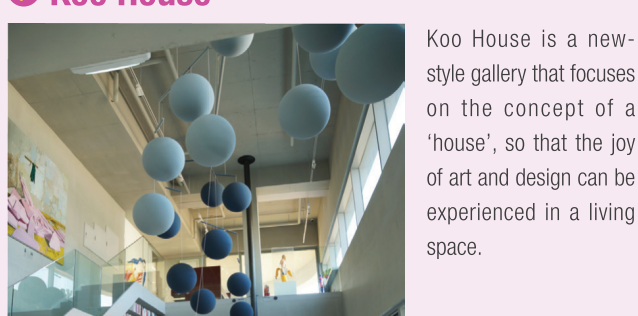
Hwang Sun-Won Sonagi Village

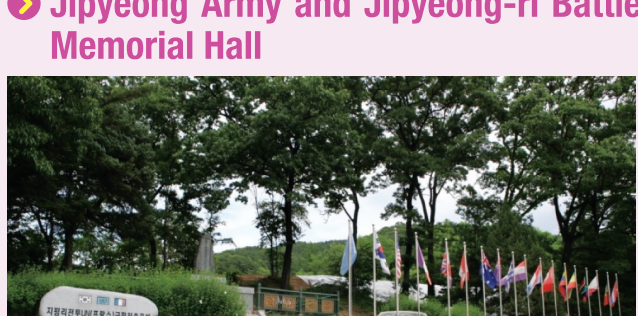
Jipyeong Brewery

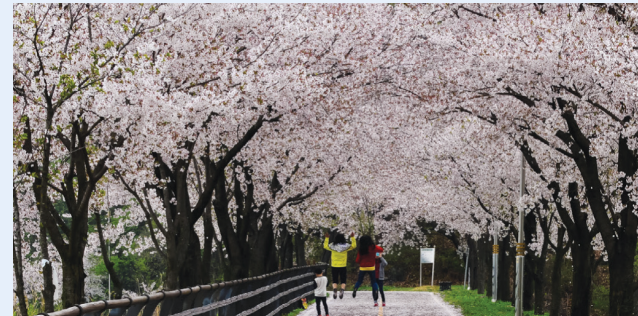


Gudun Station, opened in 1940 and closed in 2012, is famous as a filming site of Architecture 101.

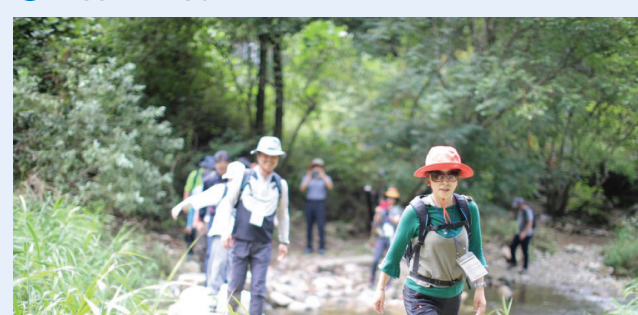
Namhangang Bike Path

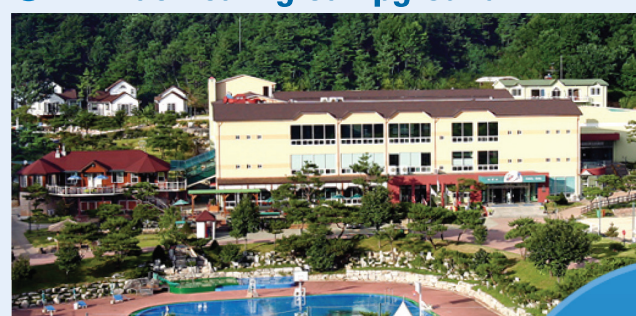
Canoe

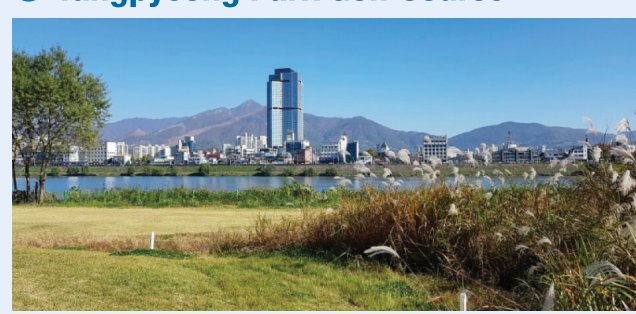
Yongmunsan Wild Vegetable Festival

Yangpyeong Mulmalgeun Market (3rd and 8th day)



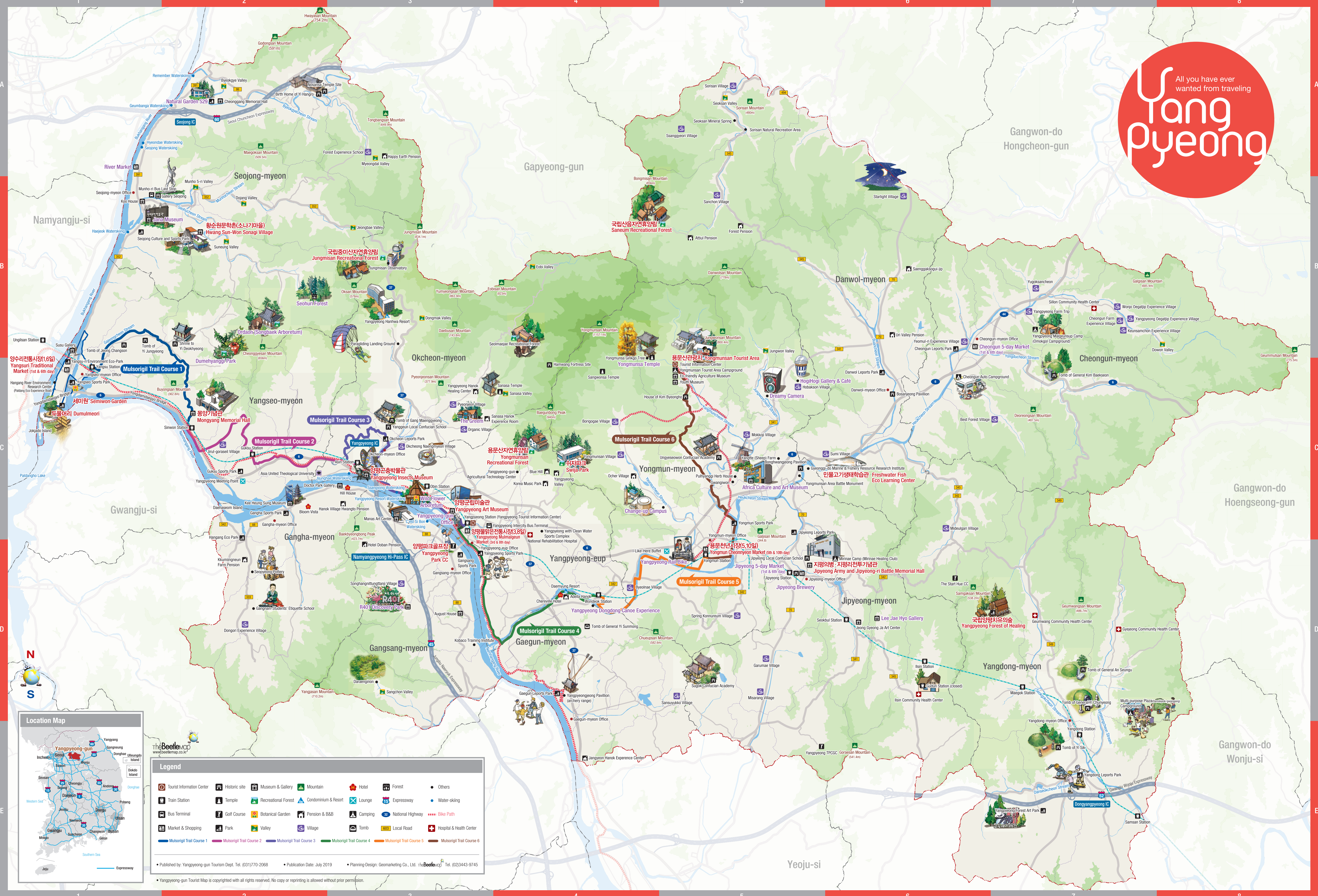
