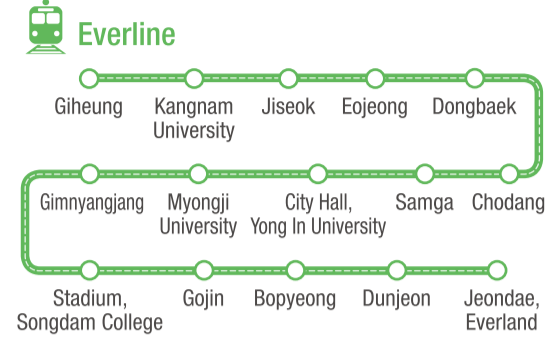

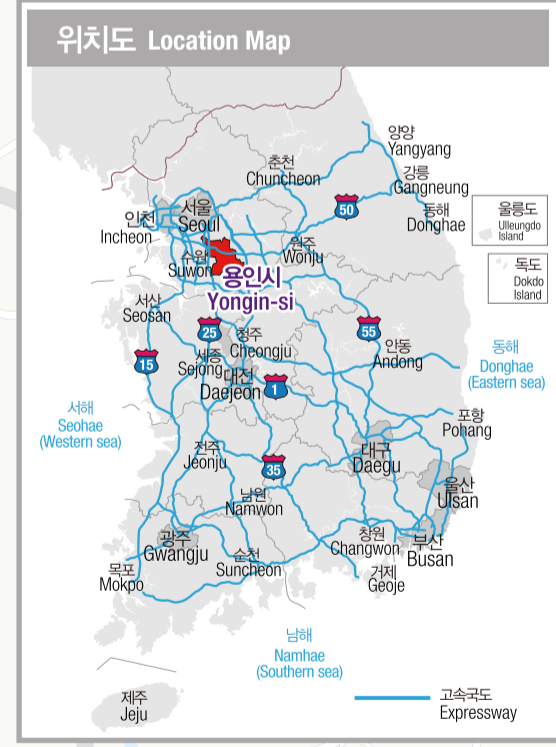

03 Cultural Properties

Yongin Simgokseowon B2 Confucian Academy (Historical Site No. 530)



The academy, built in commemoration of Jo Gwang-jo (Jeongnam, 1482-1519), shows the typical structure of Confucian academies in the Joseon Dynasty era, with the lecture hall located in the front and a shrine in the back. Of many academies dedicated to Jo Gwang-jo, this is the only one left after the abolition of Confucian academies ordered by Heungseon Daewongun in 1871.

Chungnyeol Confucian Academy A3 (Gyeonggi-do Tangible Cultural Property No. 9)



The original building of the Confucian academy, built in the 9th year of King Seonjo's reign (1576, the Joseon Dynasty period) in commemoration of Poen Jeong Mong-ju's integrity and virtue (1337-1392), was lost in a fire during the Japanese Invasion of Korea in 1592 and rebuilt in the same king's 38-year reign (1605). In 1608, King Gwanghae bestowed the name and signboard on the academy.

Cheonseong Fortress D3 (Gyeonggi-do Monument No. 44)



During the 2nd invasion of the Mongolian Army (in the 19th year of King Gojong's reign, 1232), General Kim Yun-hu killed the enemy commander, Saridag, which is why the site is called 'Site of Death,' and led the army of Goryeo to victory. Not just the soldiers but the ordinary citizens of the Cheoin area significantly contributed to the great victory, which strengthened unification of the people and their sense of sovereignty.

House of Yi Clan in Hansan C3 (Gyeonggi-do Folk Cultural Property No. 10)



House of Yi Ja (1480-1533), known for his virtuous conduct, was built during the reign of King Jungjong (the Joseon Dynasty period). The building reflects the typical structure of house for the middle class during the Joseon Dynasty era.

Three-story Stone Pagoda in Eobi-ri E4 (Gyeonggi-do Tangible Cultural Property No. 194)



Originally, it was built at Eobirisa Temple site but lost during the Japanese Invasion of Korea in 1592. Later, the residents of the area rebuilt the stone pagoda on the original site, which was submerged in 1963 due to the construction of a reservoir and then moved to the current site. It has the typical stone pagoda structure shown during the latter part of the Silla Dynasty, composed of a two-level stylobate, 4-level support made of separate stone and capstone for the body, and steep roofs.

House of Chang Uccchin B2 (Registered Cultural Property No. 404)



This is the house where Artist Chang Uccchin lived from 1986 to 1990. He renovated an old hanok, built in 1984, into his workshop and private home. The Western-style house was designed and constructed by the artist himself in 1988 for his later years, based on the one in his work 'Scene with a Car.'

Yongin Jungang Market C4



Jungang Market, founded in the 1960s, became the center of commerce and transportation in Yongin around the 1990s and is still cherished by the residents. The market is full of things to eat, see, and enjoy, and it is especially famous for the sundae alley (blood sausage), rice cake alley, and fashion accessory alley.
